Meeting called to order at 7:35

- New People:

- Secretary's Report
 - Review of February Minutes
 - 2020 Memberships to date: 106
- AP Showers – April 24th – 26th
 - Trailer is currently at Alan's house in Aurora, we need a hauler (club member) to pull it to Brothers launch site. It is a double axle trailer in the neighborhood of 5,000 lbs. The club pays \$75 to whoever volunteers.
 - Will need a hauler from the launch site to the Stage Stop in Brothers afterward as well
 - Need volunteers for setup. David B. won't be available this year in the middle of the week for setup.
 - Setup usually isn't an issue in terms of volunteers. We need more people to stick around for tear down.

- Garden Home Launches

 - There is no more baseball field, and there is no immediate plan to convert it to a dog park.
- Treasurer's Report
 - Balance Last Report: \$9,797.67
 - Credits: \$870.34
 - Debts: \$332.48
 - Balance This Report: \$10,335.53
 - Used porta-potties: there aren't used ones available from our service vendor after all, so we will be buying new ones. They are roughly \$600 each (twice the used price). The plan was to buy 4 (2 replacements and 2 additional). The BOD will have more discussion maybe, but we will probably still go for it as they are definitely needed.
 - Storage Trailer: \$1100 to ship it to Brothers. Landowners do not want to store it on the launch site property. The Brothers-Hampton RFPA is interested in splitting the cost and sharing the storage space. Another option is trading the RFPA for a 20 ft trailer they currently own. David Armstrong will have a final decision hopefully by the next meeting.
 - Low Power launch system: Sunriver Bob might have one. George Rachor will follow-up. New old Stock of the same model we currently have from Pratt.
